Finished 9th at 2021 an 2020 European Ch. Finished 2nd at 2021 Osijek - World Challenge Cup event. In other events - silver in team at 2020 European Ch, bronze in horizontal bar in 2021. Sustained a foot injury during the 2020 European Ch that meant that he could not compete in floor or vault but he still claimed a silver medal with the Turkish team.

Placed 8th at 2018 WCh. Bronze at 2015 PanAm Games. Gold at 2021, 2018 PanAm Ch, bronze in 2014. Gold at 2012 South American Ch. In other events - 9th in team at 2020 OG, 17th in all-around, 25th in floor, 36th in pommel horse. In 2019, he became the first Brazilian gymnast to win a gold medal in the all-around event at the PanAm Games. Serves in the Air Force.				
<b>3</b>	<b>NAGORNYI Nikita</b>	<b>ROC</b>	<b>12 FEB 1997</b>	<b>14.783(3)</b>
Placed 5th at 2016 OG. Gold at 2019 WCh, 5th in 2018. Gold at 2015 European Ch, 7th in 2021, 9th in 2019, 6th in 2016. In other events - gold in team at 2020 OG, bronze in all-around, 7th in floor, 14th in pommel horse. Wife Daria SPIRIDONOVA won silver in the team event at the 2016 OG. In 2018 he founded Champions Academy gymnastics school in Putilkovo, near Moscow, Russian Federation.				
<b>4</b>	<b>DAVTYAN Artur</b>	<b>ARM</b>	<b>8 AUG 1992</b>	<b>14.866(2)</b>
Finished 11th at 2016 OG, 15th in 2012. Placed 25th at 2019 WCh, 7th in 2018. Silver at 2016 European Ch, bronze in 2013, 6th in 2021. In other events - 13th in pommel horse at 2020 OG. He suffered a back injury in 2020. Older brother Vahagn won silver in rings at the 2016 European Ch and bronze in 2019.				
<b>5</b>	<b>ONDER Ahmet</b>	<b>TUR</b>	<b>12 JUL 1996</b>	<b>14.466(8)</b>
DNF at 2018 WCh. Finished 12th at 2021 European Ch, 8th in 2020, 18th in 2019. In other events - 13th in floor at 2020 OG, 24th in all-around, 39th in pommel horse. He speaks four languages: Turkish, English, German and Bulgarian.				
<b>6</b>	<b>SHIN Jaehwan</b>	<b>KOR</b>	<b>3 MAR 1998</b>	<b>14.866(1)</b>
In 2019/20 season, finished 5th at Doha World Cup event, 1st in Baku and Melbourne, 6th at Turnier der Meister, 8th in Baku. Placed 2nd at 2019 Zhaoqing World Challenge Cup event. In other events - 4th in floor exercise at 2019 Zhaoqing World Challenge Cup event.				
<b>7</b>	<b>ABLIAZIN Denis</b>	<b>ROC</b>	<b>3 AUG 1992</b>	<b>14.733(5)</b>
Silver at 2016 and 2012 OG. Finished 6th at 2015 WCh, 8th in 2014. Gold at 2017, 2014, 2013 European Ch, silver in 2015, 7th in 2016. In other events - gold in team at 2020 OG, 18th in floor exercise. Silver in team, bronze in rings at 2016 OG. Bronze in floor exercise at 2012 OG. 'I played ice hockey and did BMX for some time but as there were no results, I decided to try myself in gymnastics.'				
<b>8</b>	<b>YULO Carlos Edriel</b>	<b>PHI</b>	<b>16 FEB 2000</b>	<b>14.712(6)</b>
Placed 12th at 2019 WCh, 9th in 2018. Finished 4th at 2018 Asian Games. In other events - won floor at 2019 WCh, bronze in 2018. In 2018 he became the first artistic gymnast representing the Philippines to win a medal at the WCh when he won bronze in floor exercise. In 2019, he then became the first artistic gymnast representing the Philippines to win gold at the WCh. Relocated to Tokyo in 2017.				
<b>R1</b>	<b>YANG Hakseon</b>	<b>KOR</b>	<b>6 DEC 1992</b>	<b>14.366(9)</b>
Gold at 2012 OG. Gold at 2013, 2011 WCh, 8th in 2019, 9th in 2017, 7th in 2014, 4th in 2010. In other events - 11th in team at 2020 OG. In 2012 he became the first athlete representing KOR to win a gold medal in artistic gymnastics at OG. In March 2016 he injured his right Achilles during training and required surgery that caused him to miss the Olympics in Rio. Nicknamed 'The God of Vault'.				
<b>R2</b>	<b>SHEK Wai Hung</b>	<b>HKG</b>	<b>10 OCT 1991</b>	<b>14.274(12)</b>
Finished 13th at 2012 OG. Placed 7th at 2019 and 2011 WCh, 6th in 2018 and 2014, 24th in 2017, 10th in 2015. Gold at 2018 and 2014 Asian Games. In other events - silver in horizontal bar at 2015 Asian Ch. He was a torch bearer as the Olympic torch made its way through Hong Kong, China ahead of 2008 OG in Beijing. In 2012, he became the first male gymnast to represent HKG at the Olympic Games.
