He won gold at the 2021 European Ch just three weeks after testing positive for Covid-19: 'After I tested positive, I sank into despair a bit. As there is no room for mistakes in gymnastics. There is also no room for desperation.'

Two-time world champion in 2018 and 2017, 16th in 2019. Gold at 2018 Asian Games. Gold at 2017 Asian Ch. Bronze at 2014 Pacific Rim Ch, 9th in 2016. In other events - bronze in team at 2020 OG, 12th in pommel horse. Gold in team at 2018 WCh, silver in 2019. Gold in rings and team at 2017 Asian Ch, silver in pommel horse. He was troubled by a shoulder injury at the 2019 World Championships.				
3	MIKULAK Samuel	USA	13 OCT 1992	15.433(5)
Placed 14th at 2016 OG, 13th in 2012. Placed 28th at 2019 WCh, 4th in 2018, 11th in 2013. Bronze at 2015 PanAm Games. Silver at 2018 Pacific Rim Ch, bronze in 2012. In other events - 5th in team at 2020 OG, 12th in all-around, 15th in floor, 23rd in pommel horse, 25th in rings. He was on a mental health panel presented by USA Gymnastics in May 2021: 'I had a 'fake it till I make it' mentality.'				
4	YOU Hao	CHN	26 APR 1992	15.666(3)
Finished 8th at 2016 OG. Gold at 2015 WCh, 9th in 2014, 4th in 2013. In other events - silver in rings at 2020 OG. Bronze in team event at 2016 OG. Silver in rings at 2015 WCh, bronze in 2014. Gold in team event at 2014 WCh, bronze in 2015. He took up the sport at age four in 1996. His wife WU Jiaojiao was a coach of the gymnastics team in Jiangsu province.				
5	BELAVSKIY David	ROC	23 FEB 1992	15.325(9)
Bronze at 2016 OG, 14th in 2012. Bronze at 2017 WCh, 7th in 2018, 13th in 2015. Gold at 2016 European Ch, silver in 2021, 2018 and 2014, bronze in 2013. In other events - gold in team at 2020 OG, 4th in pommel horse, 23rd in rings, 26th in all-around, 59th in floor. He launched his personal sportswear collection in 2019. 'We created a name brand that is now accessible to everyone.'				
6	PAKHNIUK Petro	UKR	26 NOV 1991	15.333(8)
Finished 51st at 2016 OG. Placed 7th at 2019 WCh, 13th in 2018, 22nd in 2017, 16th in 2014. Silver at 2020 and 2019 European Ch. In other events - 7th in team at 2020 OG, 19th in individual all-around, 40th in rings. He competed for UKR until 2013 before switching allegiances to AZE for two years then changing back to UKR in 2017, after approval from the International Gymnastics Federation.				
7	FRASER Joe	GBR	6 DEC 1998	15.400(7)
Gold at 2019 WCh, 50th in 2018. Placed 45th at 2021 European Ch, 19th in 2019, 8th in 2018, 20th in 2017. Gold at 2016 Junior WCh. In other events - 4th in team at 2020 OG, 9th in individual all-around, 11th in pommel horse, 12th in rings, 23rd in floor exercise. He was born with six fingers on each hand and had an operation to remove the extra fingers when he was a baby.				
8	DAUSER Lukas	GER	15 JUN 1993	15.733(2)
Finished 19th at 2016 OG. Placed 8th at 2019 and 2018 WCh, 25th in 2014. Silver at 2017 European Ch, bronze in 2021, 11th in 2019. In other events - 8th in team at 2020 OG, 18th in all-around, 30th in pommel horse, 32nd in floor. The International Gymnastics Federation named an element on parallel bars after him in 2015. 'The Dauser' involves a giant swing backward with Makuts to upper arm hang.				
R1	HASHIMOTO Daiki	JPN	7 AUG 2001	15.300(10)
First Olympics. In other events - gold in individual all-around at 2020 OG, silver in team event, 9th in pommel horse, 10th in floor exercise, 27th in rings. Bronze in team event at 2019 WCh. He was influenced by his older brothers Takuya and Kengo, who have competed in artistic gymnastics at club and university level in Japan.				
R2	TANIGAWA Wataru	JPN	23 JUL 1996	15.241(11)
Finished 50th at 2019 WCh, 13th in 2018, 11th in 2017. In other events - silver in team at 2020 OG, 14th in floor exercise, 17th in rings, 25th in pommel horse, 28th in individual all-around. Bronze in team event at 2019 and 2018 WCh. His younger brother Kakeru has represented JPN in artistic gymnastics, and won a bronze medal in the team event at the 2019 World Championships.
