Finished 42nd at 2016 OG. Placed 6th at WCh in 2019 and 2018, 36th in 2017, 38th in 2015. Gold at 2021 and 2016 European Ch, 10th in 2019, 4th in 2018. In other events - gold in team event at 2020 OG, bronze in all-around. Silver in team event at 2016 OG. Gold in vault at 2019 WCh. His wife Daria SPIRIDONOVA (ROC) won a silver medal in the team event for ROC at the 2016 Olympics.				
2	ZAPATA Rayderley	ESP	26 MAY 1993	15.041(4)
Finished 11th at 2016 OG. Bronze at 2015 WCh, 21st in 2018, 8th in 2014. Placed 6th at European Ch in 2019 and 2017, 7th in 2018, 11th in 2016, 5th in 2015. He was born in Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic before moving to Spain at age nine. He considered retiring from gymnastics when he was 17 because people told him he was too old for the sport.				
3	MOLDAUER Yul	USA	26 AUG 1996	14.866(6)
Bronze at 2017 WCh, 4th in 2018, 10th in 2019. In other events - 5th in team event at 2020 OG, 29th in all-around. Won 2019, 2018 and 2017 American Cup. Born in Republic of Korea and named Kyung-Tae by his chemically-dependant mother before he was adopted by a couple in the USA. He had very little hair when he was a baby so they decided to name him after bald actor Yul BRYNNER.				
4	DOLGOPYAT Artem	ISR	16 JUN 1997	15.200(1)
Silver at WCh in 2019 and 2017, 5th in 2018. Gold at 2020 European Ch, silver in 2019 and 2018, 4th in 2017, 20th in 2015. In other events - bronze in vault at 2020 European Ch. He became the first Israeli gymnast to win a silver medal at the World Championships when he placed second at the 2017 edition of the tournament in Montreal.				
5	KIM Hansol	KOR	29 DEC 1995	14.900(5)
Finished 35th at 2016 OG. Placed 7th at 2019 WCh, 14th in 2018, 8th in 2017, 6th in 2015, 5th in 2014. Silver at 2012 Asian Ch, bronze in 2017, 4th in 2015. Gold at 2018 Asian Games. In other events - 11th in team event at 2020 OG, 39th in all-around. Bronze in vault at 2017 WCh. He fractured his left shin at the 2016 Olympics in Rio.				
6	RYU Sunghyun	KOR	22 OCT 2002	15.066(3)
Gold at 2019 Junior WCh. In 2019/2020 season - finished 1st in Melbourne, 4th in Baku. In other events - 11th in team event at 2020 OG, 41st in all-around. His father played football and was initially opposed to him training as a gymnast. It took three years for him and his coach to persuade his father to let him do the sport.				
7	XIAO Ruoteng	CHN	30 JAN 1996	14.866(7)
Bronze at 2019 WCh, 14th in 2018, 11th in 2017, 28th in 2015. Silver at 2017 Asian Ch, 9th in 2015. Finished 6th at 2018 Asian Games. In other events - silver in all-around at 2020 OG, bronze in team event. Gold in pommel horse and team event at 2018 WCh. He was unable to compete at the 2016 Olympics due to an elbow injury he suffered in training, before returning to competition in 2017.				
8	KARIMI Milad	KAZ	21 JUN 1999	14.766(8)
Finished 12th at 2019 WCh, 17th in 2018 and 9th in 2017. Silver at 2019 Asian Ch, 6th in 2017. Finished 5th at 2018 Asian Games. In other events - 21st in all-round event at 2020 OG. Bronze in vault at 2019 Asian Ch. He broke his arm in three places after a fall from the parallel bars at a World Cup event in Melbourne, Australia in February 2018.				
R1	WISKUS Shane	USA	1 OCT 1998	14.733(9)
First reserve. Finished 81st at 2019 WCh. In other events - fifth in men's team event at 2020 OG, 30th in individual all-around. His mother put him into gymnastics in 2002 to develop his coordination and motor skills. He started competing at age seven.				
R2	HASHIMOTO Daiki	JPN	7 AUG 2001	14.700(10)
Second reserve. Finished 11th at 2019 WCh. In other events - gold in individual all-around at 2020 OG, silver in men's team event. His older brothers Takuya and Kengo have competed in artistic gymnastics at club and university level in Japan respectively. They influenced him to take up the sport.
