She was named as an alternate for the 2016 Olympics. 'The whole time I was in Rio, I probably cried every night. It was really hard to enjoy being an alternate.'

Finished 12th at 2016 OG. Bronze at 2018 WCh, 6th in 2019, 7th in 2015, 2014 and 2011. Placed 5th at 2018 PanAm Ch, 7th in 2014. Bronze at 2010 Pacific Rim Ch. In other events - 55th in all-around at 2020 OG. Bronze in team event at 2018 and 2014 PanAm Ch. She became the first MEX female artistic gymnast to win a medal at the WCh when she took bronze at the 2018 edition of the tournament.				
3	ANDRADE Rebeca	BRA	8 MAY 1999	15.100(3)
Finished 11th at 2021 PanAm Ch. In other events - silver in all-around at 2020 OG. Gold in all-around and team event at 2021 PanAm Ch, silver in team in 2018. She performed her floor exercise routine at the 2016 OG to a mix of songs by Beyonce and she has since become known as 'Rebeyonce' in Brazil. 'She obliterates everything and when I'm doing my routine I want to obliterate the competition.'				
4	CAREY Jade	USA	27 MAY 2000	15.166(2)
Silver at 2019 and 2017 WCh. Gold at 2018 PanAm Ch. In 2019/20 season - finished 1st at Melbourne, Doha, Baku, 2nd at Turnier der Meister. In other events - finished 8th in all-around at 2020 OG. Gold in team event at 2019 WCh. Silver in floor exercise at 2017 WCh. Gold in team event and floor exercise at 2018 PanAm Ch.				
5	YEO Seojeong	KOR	20 FEB 2002	14.800(5)
Finished 8th at 2019 WCh, 5th in 2018. Gold at 2018 Asian Games. In 2019/2020 season - gold at WCup event in Melbourne. In other events - 56th in all-around at 2020 OG. Her father represented KOR in artistic gymnastics and won a silver medal in vault at the 1996 Olympics. Her mother won a bronze medal in the team event for KOR at the 1994 Asian Games.				
6	OLSEN Shallon	CAN	10 JUL 2000	14.699(6)
Finished 8th at 2016 OG. Silver at 2018 WCh, 4th in 2019, 7th in 2017. Bronze at 2019 PanAm Games. Gold at 2018 CWG. Gold at 2016 Pacific Rim Ch, bronze in 2014. In other events - 10th in team event at 2020 OG, 46th in all-around. Gold in team event at 2018 CWG, bronze in floor exercise. She was the youngest CAN athlete in any sport to compete at the 2016 Olympics.				
7	MELNIKOVA Angelina	ROC	18 JUL 2000	14.616(9)
Finished 11th at 2018 WCh, 10th in 2017. Silver at 2018 European Ch, bronze in 2021, 5th in 2019, 8th in 2017. Silver at 2019 European Games. In other events - gold in team event at 2020 OG, bronze in all-around. Silver in team event at 2016 OG. Bronze in floor exercise and all-around at 2019 WCh. She started her own leotard business in 2018.				
8	AKHAIMOVA Liliia	ROC	17 MAR 1997	14.699(7)
Finished 7th at 2019 WCh, 9th in 2018. Placed 5th at 2018 European Ch. In other events - gold in team event at 2020 OG, 32nd in all-around. Silver in team event at 2019 and 2018 WCh. Gold in team event at 2018 European Ch. Her younger sister Lyubov has competed at national level in artistic gymnastics.				
R1	STEINGRUBER Giulia	SUI	24 MAR 1994	14.566(10)
First reserve. Bronze at 2016 OG, 9th in 2012. Bronze at 2017 WCh, 9th in 2019, 7th in 2015. Gold at 2021, 2016, 2014 and 2013 ECh. In other events - 15th in individual all-around at 2020 OG. She became the first Swiss athlete to win a medal in artistic gymnastics at an OG by claiming bronze in vault at the 2016 OG in Rio de Janeiro.				
R2	MURAKAMI Mai	JPN	5 AUG 1996	14.466(11)
Second reserve. Finished 13th at 2014 WCh, 12th in 2013. In other events - fifth in individual all-around and women's team event at 2020 OG. She appeared in television dramas and commercials in Japan when she was a child. She took up gymnastics at age three at Iketani Gymnastics Club in Tokyo, Japan.
