In other events - 4th in team event at 2020 OG. Gold in floor exercise in 2016 OG, bronze in all-around. He released a health and fitness book called 'The Whitlock Workout: Get Fit and Healthy in Minutes'.				
2	YODER Alec	USA	21 JAN 1997	15.200(4)
Finished 30th at 2018 WCh. Gold at 2014 Pacific Rim Ch. In other events - gold in team at 2014 Pacific Rim Ch. He underwent shoulder surgery, which forced him to withdraw from the qualifying competition for the 2016 Olympics.				
3	SUN Wei	CHN	12 AUG 1995	14.833(6)
Finished 62nd at 2019 WCh, 12th in 2018. Placed 9th at 2017 Asian Ch, 6th in 2015. Bronze at 2018 Asian Games. In other events - bronze in team event at 2020 OG, 4th in all-around. Gold at team event in 2018 WCh, silver in 2019. Gold in team event at 2017 Asian Ch. He was weak as a child and his family wanted him to take up the sport in order to improve his health.				
4	BELYAVSKIY David	ROC	23 FEB 1992	14.733(9)
Finished 5th at 2016 OG, 7th in 2012. Silver at 2017 WCh, 8th in 2019, 7th in 2018. Gold at 2017 European Ch, silver in 2016, 4th in 2018. In other events - gold in team event at 2020 OG, 26th in all-around. Silver in team at 2016 OG, bronze in parallel bars. He launched a personal sportswear collection in 2019. 'We created a name brand that is now accessible to everyone.'				
5	LEE Chih Kai	TPE	3 APR 1996	15.266(1)
Finished 31st at 2016 OG. Silver at 2019 WCh, bronze in 2018, 22nd in 2015. Placed 6th at 2019 Asian Ch, 10th in 2017, 15th in 2015. Silver at 2018 Pacific Rim Ch. In other events - 10th in team and 21st in all-around at 2020 OG. Gold in all-around at 2019 Asian Ch. He was one of several young athletes featured in the documentary called 'Jump! Boys' and the sequel 'Jump! Men' in 2017.				
6	KAYA Kazuma	JPN	19 NOV 1996	14.833(7)
Bronze at 2015 WCh, 5th in 2019, 41st in 2018. In other events - silver in team event at 2020 OG, 25th in all-around. Gold in team event at 2015 WCh. Bronze in parallel bars and team event at 2019 WCh. He was inspired to take up the sport after watching the Japanese artistic gymnastics team win the gold medal in the team event at the 2004 Olympics.				
7	Mc CLENAGHAN Rhys	IRL	21 JUL 1999	15.266(2)
Bronze at 2019 WCh, 14th in 2017. Gold at 2018 European Ch, 5th in 2021, 14th in 2017. Gold at 2018 CWG. He was teased for participating in what some consider to be a traditionally female sport. 'Everybody gets teased at school, but I never saw myself as a victim.' He became the first IRL artistic gymnast to win a medal at the World Championships when he took bronze in 2019.				
8	KAMEYAMA Kohei	JPN	28 DEC 1988	15.266(2)
Gold at 2013 WCh, 17th in 2017, 46th in 2014. In 2019/2020 season - 1st in Baku WCup event. In other events - silver in team at 2014 WCh. He announced his retirement after he was not selected for the 2016 Olympics, but he returned in December 2016 with the aspiration to compete on home soil. 'I had been thinking why I wanted to continue the sport and finally I found a reason for competing.'				
R1	PETROV Matvei	ALB	16 JUL 1990	14.733(10)
First reserve. Finished 110th at 2019 WCh, 7th in 2013. Gold at 2020 ECh, 20th in 2021. Won Osijek World Challenge Cup in June 2021. He represented Russia before making the switch to Albania. He became the first artistic gymnast from Albania to win a medal at the ECh when he won gold on pommel horse at the 2020 edition in Mersin, Turkey.				
R2	FRASER Joe	GBR	6 DEC 1998	14.666(11)
Second reserve. Finished 32nd at 2019 WCh, 62nd in 2018. Bronze at 2021 ECh, 20th in 2019. In other events - fourth at men's team event at 2020 OG, 9th in individual all-around. Gold in parallel bars at 2019 WCh. He was born with six fingers on each hand and had an operation to remove the extra digits when he was a baby.
