GAGF history

After the test edition in 2005 and the 1st Golden Age Gym Festival 2008 in Maspalomas, Canaries (ESP), the 2nd GAGF was hosted by Portimao (POR) followed by 3rd GAGF in Montecatini (ITA), 4th GAGF in Toulouse (FRA), 5th in Portoroz (SLO), 6th in Pesaro (ITA), 7th in Rethymno (GRE), 8th in Funchal (POR), and 9th in Burgas (BUL), **the 10th edition brings back the Golden Age Gym Festival to France, next to the amazing Atlantic Ocean shore, to Les Sables d'Olonne.**

General Info

From 4 to 9 October 2026, the city of Les Sables d'Olonne (Pays de la Loire / France) will host the most important European Gymnastics Over 50 Gymnastics Festival: **Golden Age Gym Festival!** The European Gymnastics Golden Age Gym Festival is not only a week of recreation but offers also the possibility to all participants to improve their abilities, to discover new activities and sports and make new friendships. This Festival for the Over 50 generation has the purpose to inform the gymnasts from 50 European Gymnastics National Federation about gymnastics benefits and let them experience different gym related activities. The gymnasts shall have the pleasure to be involved in this unique Gym Festival where group presentations and leisure activities are planned together.

The GAGF is open to gymnasts from all 50 national European federations affiliated to European Gymnastics. **European Gymnastics member Federations can register groups of people 50+.** Although there will be no precise definition of the age of the participants, they should be 50 years or older.

After several Info Meeting sessions on site, European Gymnastics and LOC have decided to offer an online Info Meeting to present the 10th Golden Age Gym Festival 2026. This decision will permit all the HODs and a lot of group leaders to attend to the info meeting in order to plan their stay in Les Sables d'Olonne in October 2026. During the one-hour meeting, the LOC will be able to present you all the important informations to prepare your experience.

The seaside to start the Golden Age Gym Festival

Top place for the sailors and faithful to the ocean which is dear to him, through the Vendée Globe it hosts every four years, the city of Les Sables d'Olonne welcomes the parade of the Golden Age Gym Festival on its famous seaside.

On the promenade, the Remblai, loved site for the people from Les Sables d'Olonne and the tourists for its refreshing air, the European participants will honour their country across around 800 meters. They will walk dressed with their beautiful colours to carry high-up their flag.

After the parade amid the local public, the participants will be brought to the site of the opening ceremony. **The show will go on.**



An arena to host the ceremonies

Exiting the area of the simple show stage and offering a unique dimension to the opening and closing ceremonies.

By choosing an Arena, surrounded by four stands to welcome the participants and the public, the LOC opens a new path for these important moments of the Golden Age Gym Festival.

In the middle of a crowd which will be fully part of the ceremonies, the performers will feel the whole energy of thousands of people.

Sound and light proposed by a new site will enlighten the senses of the spectators to start and conclude as it is supposed to be the 10th edition of the main event dedicated to European Over 50.



With talent and originality, France and Les Sables d'Olonne will showcase their savoir-faire and their unique assets.



GAGF GALA

All groups that wish to be in the gala can apply through their national federation (European Gymnastics will provide the NF's with an application form). There is no limit to how many applications each federation can send. The maximum duration of one Gala-performance is **3 minutes**.

Interested groups must accompany their application with the following information:

- Video of the performance
- Title of the music, description of the performance and exact length (max. 3 minutes in and out)
- Number of gymnasts and gender of the group members
- Colours of the costumes (important for lighting and choice of surface for the stage)
- Apparatus used and floor plan
- Whether or not the group will need help when preparing the stage.

Once the Gala-performances are chosen by the TC-GfA and all the groups are informed, the LOC will contact each of these groups to make the necessary arrangements.

To have a well-prepared event, the LOC must also ask in advance for the music used for the performance.

This will avoid uncertainties and significantly increases the quality of the entire event.

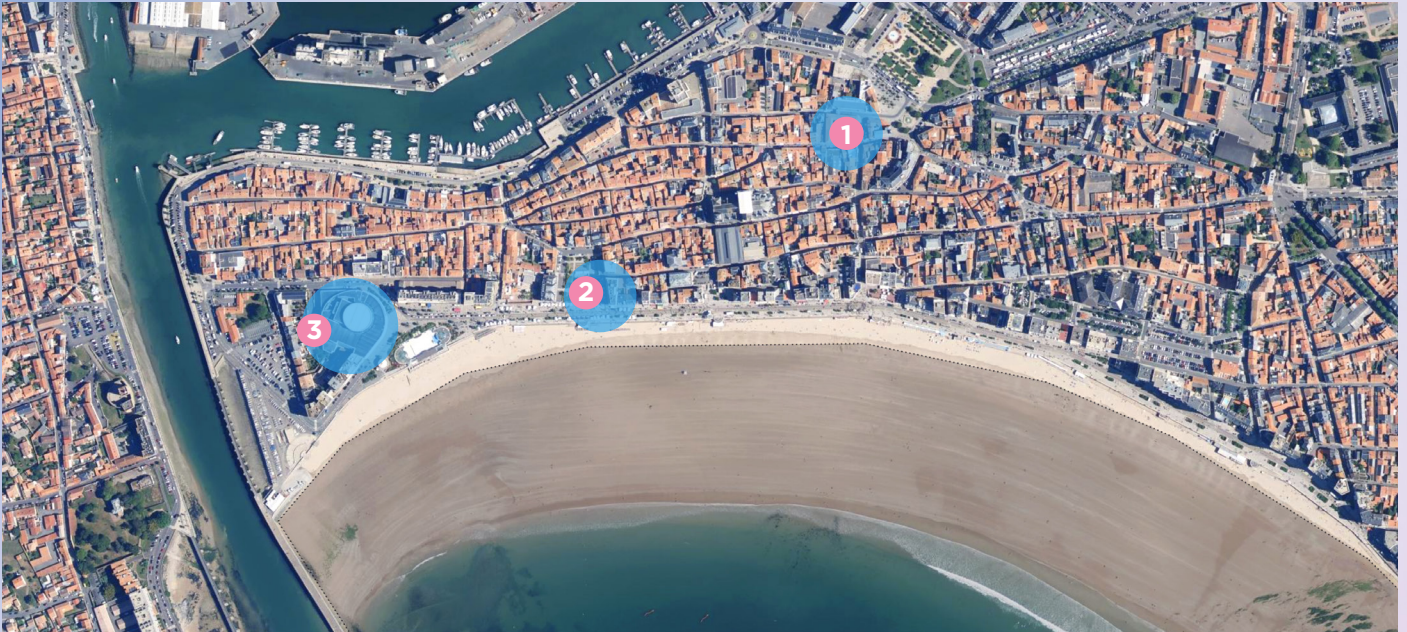
The TC-GfA will decide which groups can participate in the Gala, this decision will be taken no later than 4 months prior to the event. All the NF's that have applied will receive feedback whether their group(s) is/are withheld.

The NF send the videos within **the 4th of May 2026**; any application received past this deadline or not using the official form, will not be accepted.

The decision of the TC-GfA will be communicated within **the 4th of June 2026**.

During the Golden Age Gym Festival wild cards still can be handed out by the TC-GFA. The organising country is entitled to have at least one group in the Gala.

City performances



A red Gymnova mat will be set-up on the stages.

In case you need additional equipment, please request before the end of the 2nd registration deadline (March 15th 2026).

No guarantee can be given that the equipment requested will be available.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

The maximum time for each performance is 5 minutes (including preparation of the venue and marching in and out).

Groups should be composed of a minimum of 6 active performers and each group has the opportunity to perform twice during the week.

There will be changing rooms available at all sites. Performers should take care about props on their own.

If you should require additional help from the LOC, please provide a written request as soon as possible.

City performances



1. City hall square

In the middle of the little streets of Les Sables d'Olonne, a square full of surprises is hiding. With its buildings around, turning it into an arena, it will quickly become a place to be for everyone.

Stage: 14 m x 14 m

2. Tribunal Square

The main stage of the Golden Age Gym Festival 2026 will be turned towards the ocean. With its unique opening, it will offer a breathtaking view to the participants.

Stage: 20 m x 20 m



3. Congress Center Les Atlantes

In the very heart of the event, this indoor stage will allow to the groups which will experience their City Performance there to enjoy a perfect acoustic sound.

Stage: 14 m x 14 m

Workshops



A diversity of sport activities will be proposed from Tuesday to Friday, split in two categories: open workshops and closed workshops.

All workshops will be led by specialists of the activity and will be adapted to everyone's capacity. Each instructor will be assisted by two volunteers. This team will be at your disposal for you to enjoy the activity in the best conditions possible.

The length of each workshop is 60 minutes, including welcome time and changing room, depending on the needs.

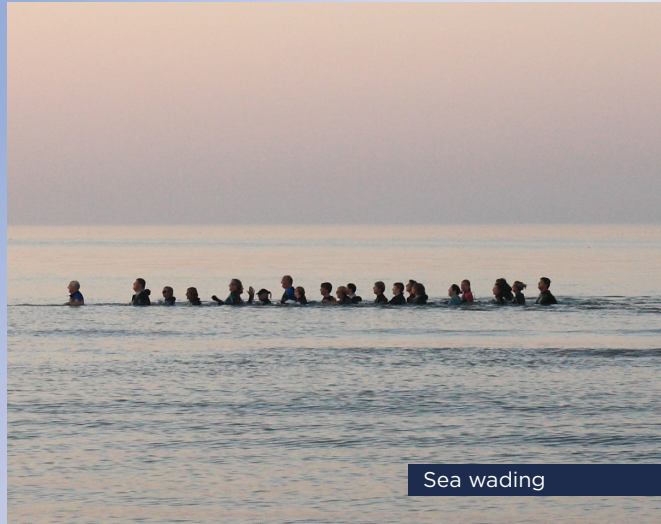

- **Responsible:** it respects the body and can be performed at every age.
- **Fun:** it is performed in a friendly environment.

It is based on a scientific thought, created in collaboration with the Institute De Gasquet (specialised of the movement and the posture) and the Institute of biomechanic Georges Charpak.
This collaboration guarantees an activity focused on solid scientific bases.

The benefits of Gym+

- **Favors the physical well-being**

- **Contributes to muscle strenghtening and increases flexibility**

A unique site to gather

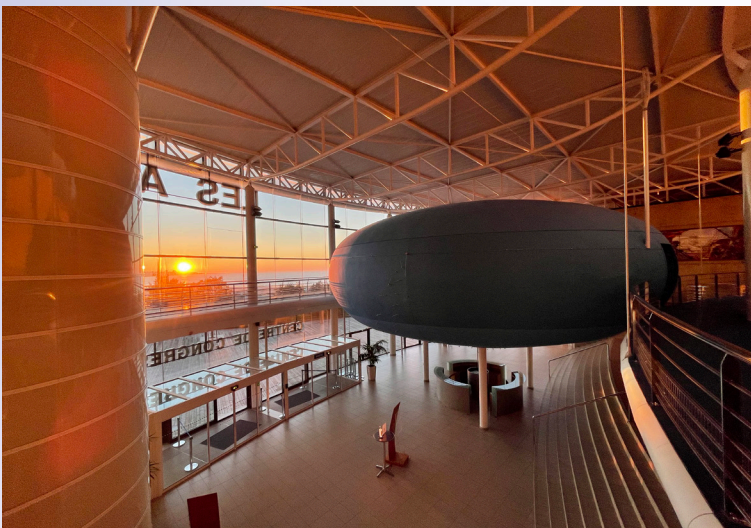

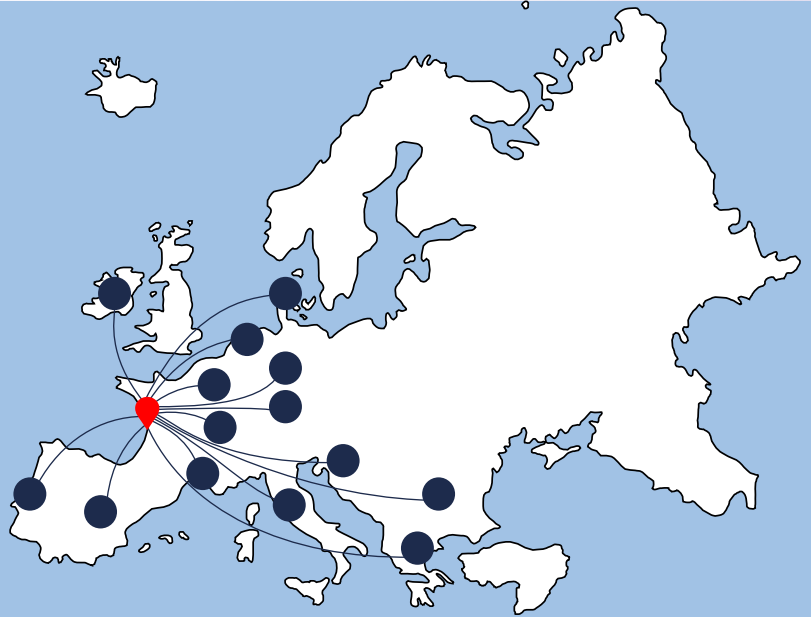
How to Get to Les Sables d'Olonne?

By Plane

You can travel to Les Sables d'Olonne by taking a flight to Nantes. This airport is located approximately 1h30 away from the host city.

Shuttle services will be available to ensure transportation between the airport and Les Sables d'Olonne. The prices of these shuttles will be provided in Bulletin No. 2.

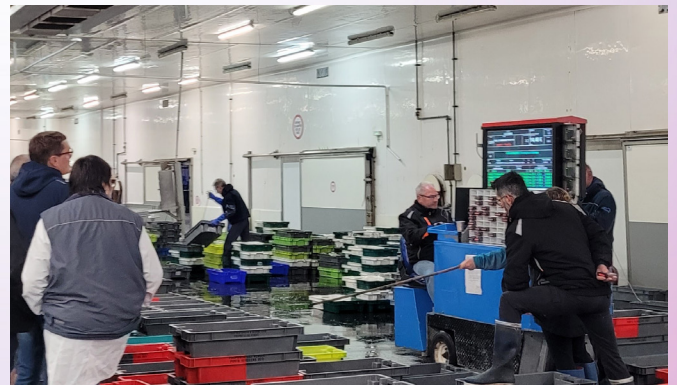

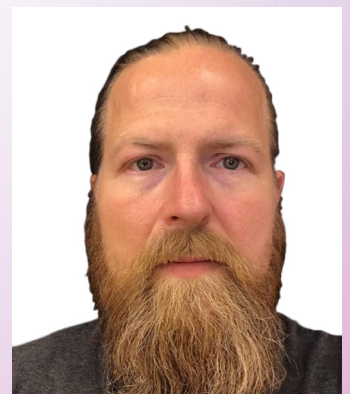

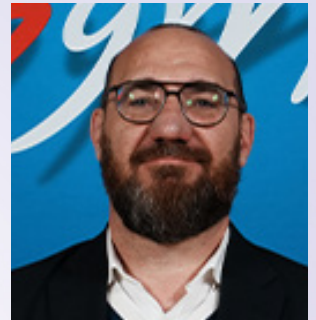
